The program uniquely adjusts to each student. With other Title IX programs, the learner can simply hit "play" and disengage while the program plays on.

U Got This! is designed to further the conversation students began during orientation regarding:

- Rape Culture
- Consent and Sexual Assault
- Dating and Domestic Violence
- Healthy Relationships
- Sexual Harassment
- Stalking

Requirements

- Required for all undergraduate students who have earned 54 credits by the end of the semester.
- Students are required to earn at least 80% on the post test and will be prompted to retake the test until they achieve this score.
- Satisfactory completion of the program is required in order to remove a registration hold for fall term 2022

2022 Launch Information

- Undergraduate program launched on February 16, 2022 and is available to designated students until completed.
- 2022 cohort is 5879 undergraduate students.
- Current undergraduate completion rate: 68% as of 3/24/22

Waiver Option

- Disclosure statement in introductory letter: "The training contains sensitive material involving sexual and interpersonal violence."
- Introductory videos also provide trigger warnings.
- Students may request a waiver from the Dean of Students office or the Office of Institutional Equity.
