


GHG Summary Status

Recap of UConn Projects



Completed Projects

- 1. Solar Array- Solar array on the roof of Science 1 is complete and operating. This is around a 1/2 megawatt.
- 2. Solar Tree showcased during Earth Day event
- 3. Solar Panels were added to 9 bus stops
- 4. Electric vehicles dining services now has 1 new service vehicle that's electric.
- 5. Spring Fling Earth Day Event showcased H2 powered generator charging an electric vehicle and 2 hydrogen vehicles.

Ongoing Projects

- 1. Conservation program continues as we advance the SLED (Storrs LED lighting) program, ASHRAE audits, etc.
- 2. Solar Canopy Parking Lots RFP in process
- 3. Fuel Cells RFP in process
- 4. Hydrogen Vehicles + Fueling Station purchase of 12 vehicles in process and determining details for the purchase of a fueling station.
- 5. Electric Buses WRTD will be getting new electric busses
- 6. Carbon Reduction Working Group will continue to meet through the semester, this group will discuss relevant topics and updates towards achieving the University Carbon Neutral Goal by 2030
 - As part of this group's efforts, Carbon Neutral Coffee Talks with experts from the UConn Faculty and Staff will continue.
 - President's website and supporting websites (Facilities, UPDC, Sustainability) will continue to provide updates and data.
